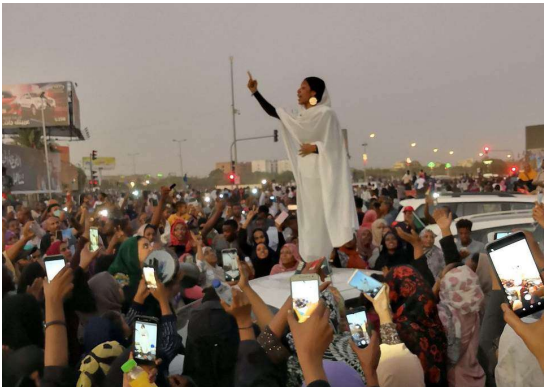




## Round-Table Conversation
