## Power, resistance & the agenda behind the 2014 Uganda Anti homosexuality act

In February, the Uganda anti-homosexuality Act 2014 was signed into law by sitting President Museveni. The law includes life imprisonment for living in a same-sex relation, and for acts of "aggravated homosexuality". Furthermore, the law criminalises what is called "the promotion of homosexuality".

To enlighten the situation that the LGBTQ communities now faces in Uganda, a screening of Roger Ross Williams's award winning documentary *God Loves Ugandan* is hosted by Etnograferna and Forum for Africa Studies.

The screening will be followed by a panel discussion on the consequences of the law in Uganda and the increasing oppression by LGBTQ communities.
